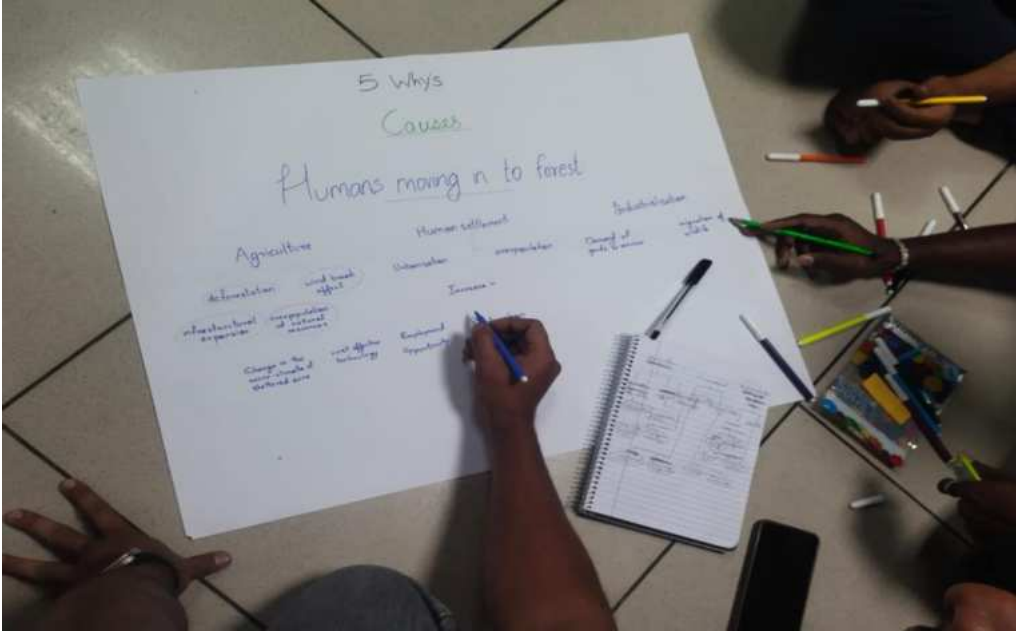


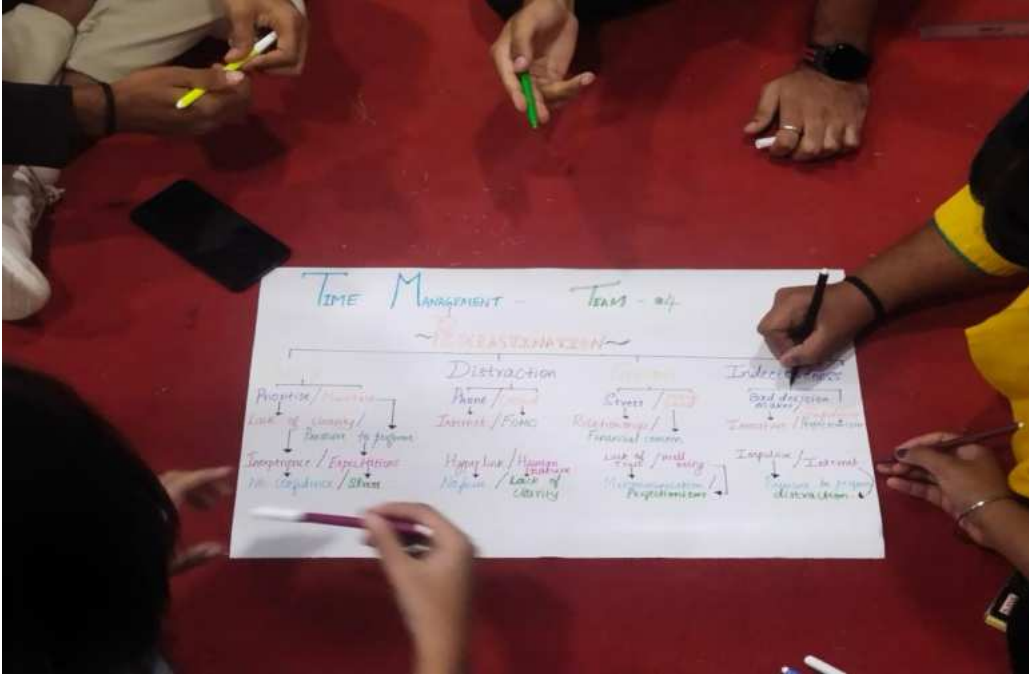
Design Thinking Workshop in progress for BBA General & Digital Marketing students
