### **Description of the event**

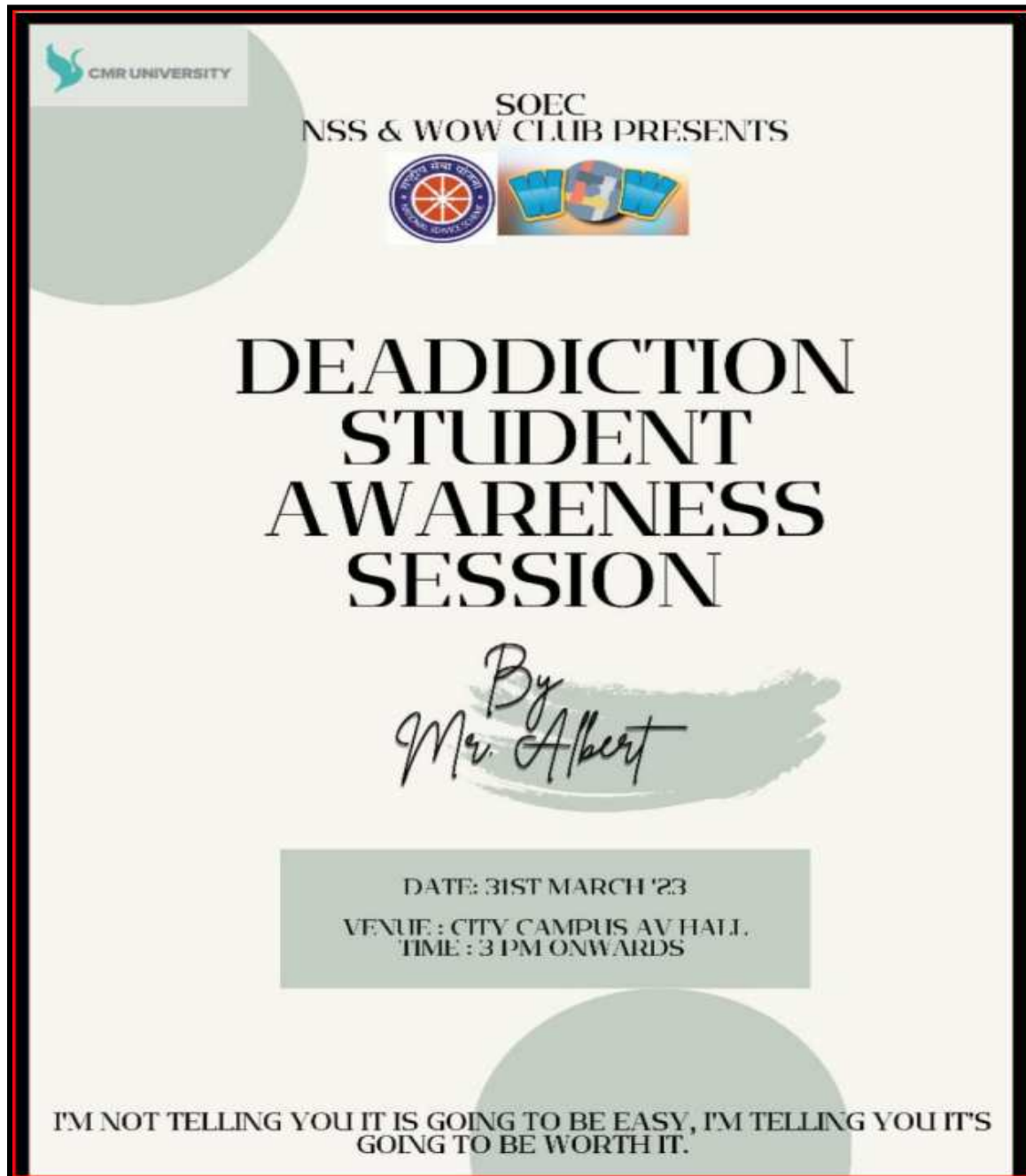

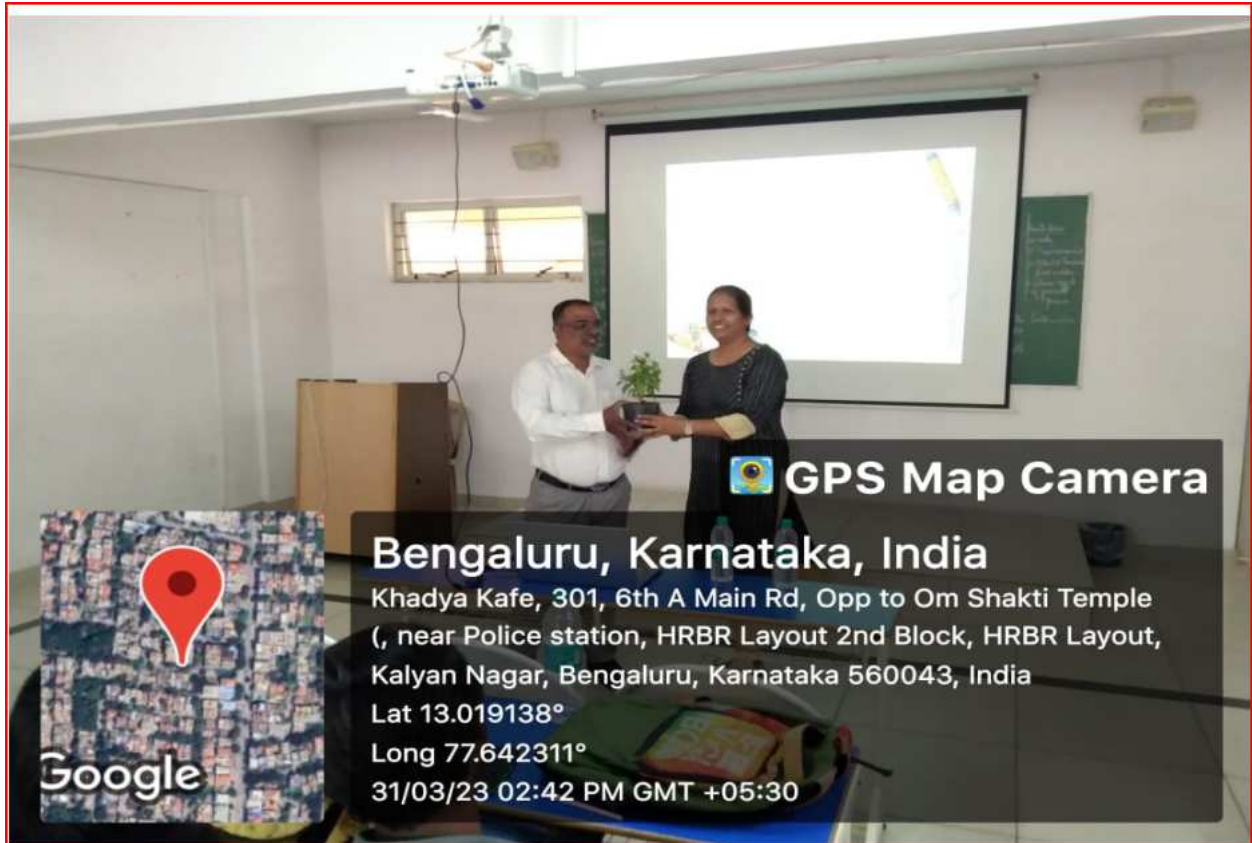

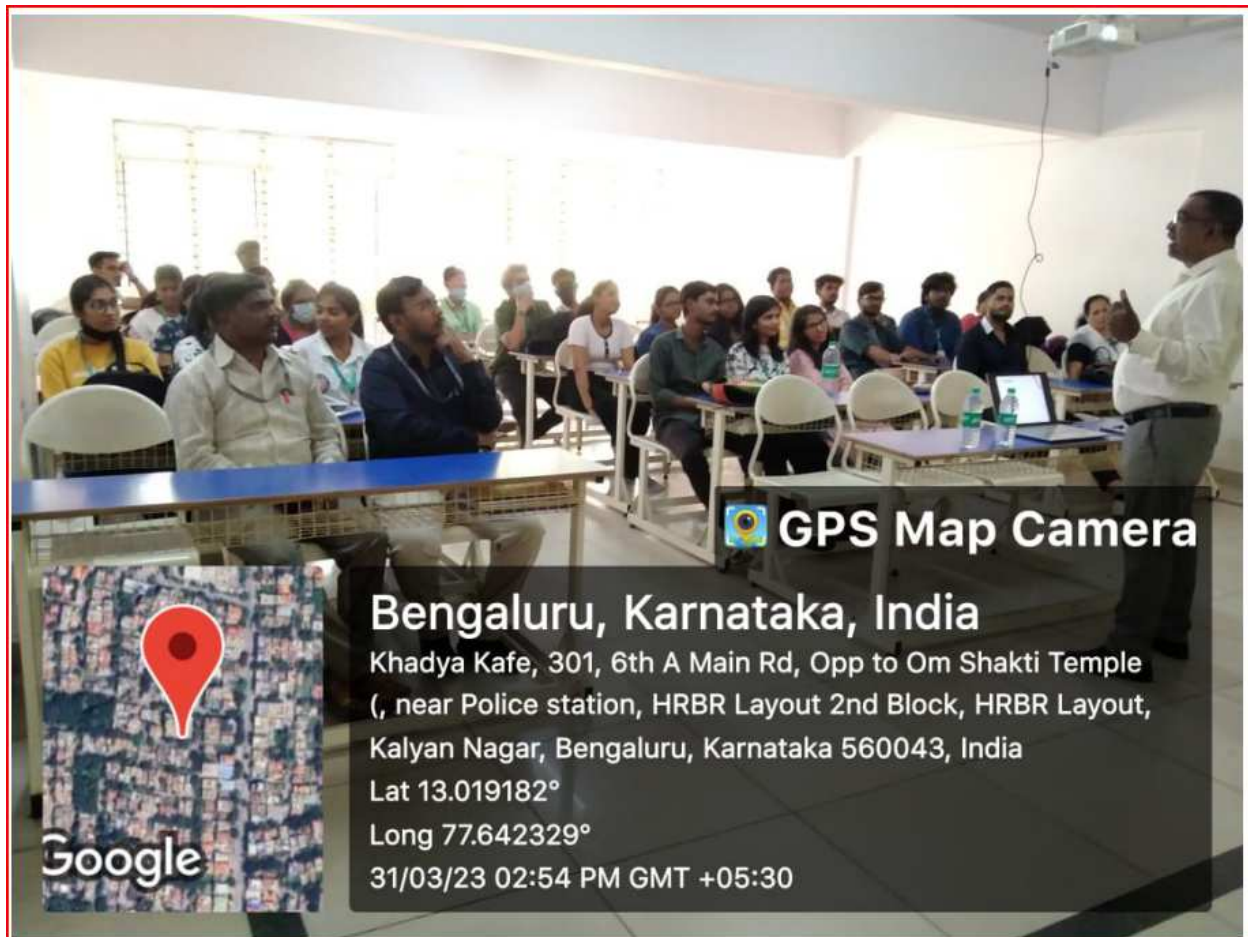
