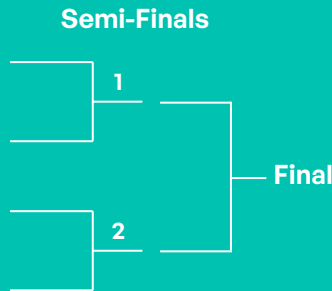

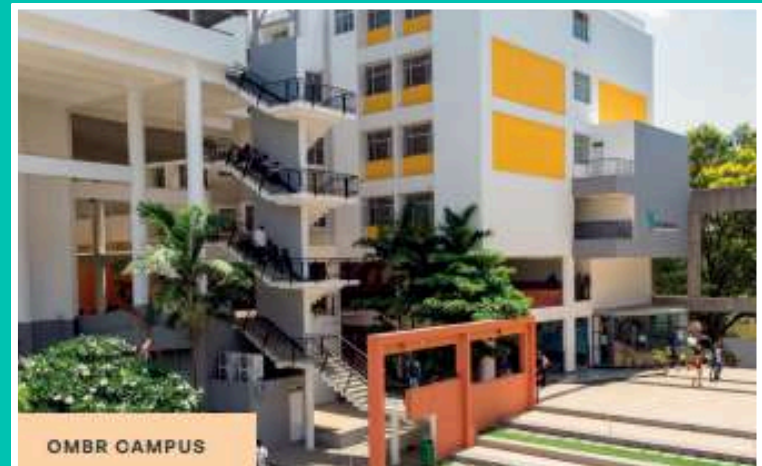

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARTICIPANTS

1. Reception

2. Accommodation

- Teams will be accommodated in the university campus hostels, with nominal charges for bedding
- Accommodation will be available 12 hours prior to the commencement of matches, and teams must vacate immediately if they fail to qualify for the next round.
- An accommodation counter will be set up at CMR University. Team Managers are requested to contact the accommodation in-charges at the tournament venue.
- Each team must pay a refundable caution deposit of ₹3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand Only) at the time of check-in. This deposit will be refunded at departure after deducting any damage costs.
- The organizing committee has made arrangements for on-campus food services upon request.
 - Meal booking: Team Managers must book meals at least one day in advance by making payment and collecting coupons.
 - Food menu: South Indian cuisine.
 - Cost: ₹300 per person per day (includes Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner).

2. Accommodation (Continued)

- Nearby food options: Food facilities are also available near the tournament venue for teams that prefer to make their own arrangements.
- Teams are required to bring their own locks and keys for security.
- **Bedding charges:**
 - ₹200 per head per day (Team of 5 players × ₹200 per day × 3 days = ₹3,000, payable at the time of accommodation registration).
 - Free accommodation will be provided for Team Managers and Coaches.

3. Managers' Meeting

- The Team Managers' Meeting will be held at the university campus. All Team Managers are requested to attend.

4. Eligibility & Documents

a. Eligibility Proforma & Registration

- Four copies of the eligibility proforma for players must be duly typed and signed by the Director of Physical Education / Sports officers of the participating University.
- Players' identity cards, a copy of the subscription receipt, and the AIU Registration Fee Receipt obtained from AIU New Delhi must be submitted to the Organizing Secretary at the time of registration.

b. Supporting Documents for Eligibility

- As per amendments/modifications in the eligibility rules for National University Games participation:
 - Undergraduate (UG) Players: Must submit photocopies of their Diploma, 10th, and/or +12/Intermediate pass certificates.
 - Postgraduate (PG) Players: Must submit photocopies of their 10th, +12, and Graduation certificates, along with their Aadhar Card.
 - These documents must be duly attested by the Director of Physical Education of the concerned university and submitted to the organizing university.

5. Officiating Charges & Match Ball Regulations

a. Officiating Charges

- The Manager of each team must pay an officiating charge of ₹1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) per match to the organizing committee before the commencement of their match.

b. Match Ball Charges & Regulations

- A fee of ₹600/- (Rupees Six Hundred Only) will be collected for a box set of three balls.
- The match balls will be supplied by the organizing committee. No other balls will be permitted in the tournament.

c. Team Readiness & Ball Receipt

- Teams must be ready at least **30 minutes** before the scheduled start time of their matches.
- The Manager or Coach must produce the ball receipt whenever requested by referees, umpires, or officials.

6. Competition Rules & Schedule

General Rules

a. Match Regulations

- Matches will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) as adapted by AIU, New Delhi.

b. Match Schedule & Reporting

- Teams must strictly follow the match schedule and report at least 30 minutes before the commencement of their matches.
- Proper uniform is mandatory for all players.

6. Competition Rules & Schedule (Continued)

General Rules

c. Organising Committee & Rule Changes

- The decision of the organising committee on all matters related to the tournament shall be final and binding.
- The Organizing Secretary reserves the right to change the venue, date, or time of matches if necessary.

d. Protests & Appeals

- Any protest regarding the conduct of the competition must be submitted in writing to the Organizing Secretary.
- The protest must be accompanied by a protest fee of ₹2,500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred Only) and must be submitted within two hours of the conclusion of the concerned match.
- The Jury of Appeal will review the protest and take necessary action on the spot.

e. Withdrawal from Competition

- If a team decides to withdraw from participation, it must inform the organizing committee at least one week before the competition.

b. Weather Information


- The climate in Bengaluru during the competition is expected to be warm, with daily temperatures increasing.
