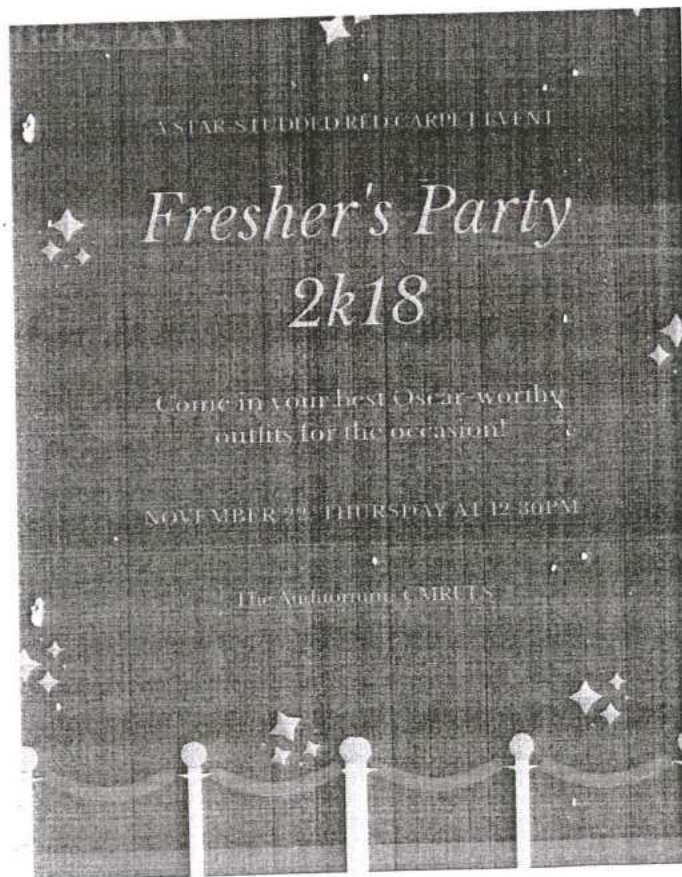


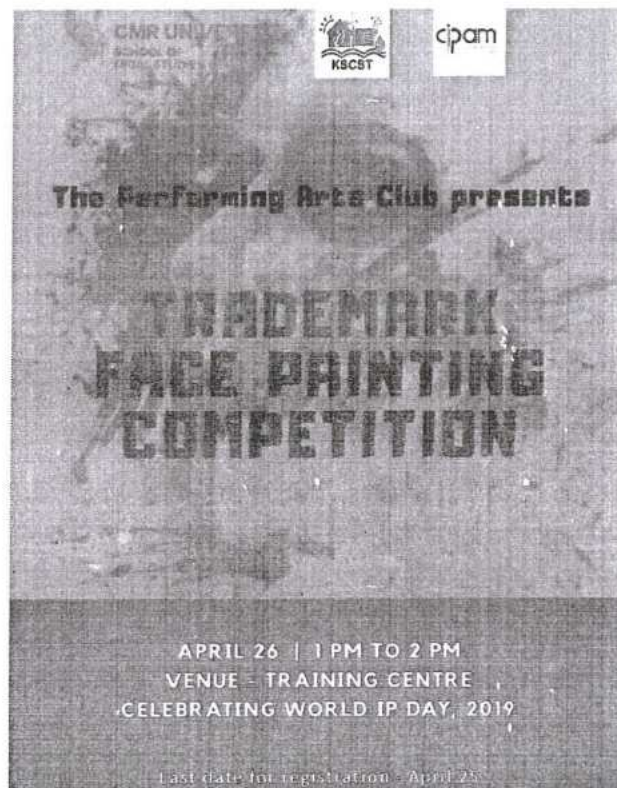

Lyrics of a song were shown in English and the students had to guess the song name and sing the song in their language.

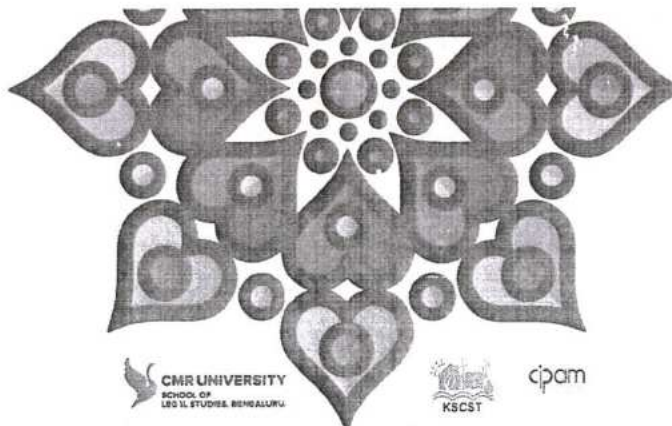
It just did not end here, the audience and teachers had also guessed few songs and sung them. At the end we had three winners and each of them were also given certificates.
