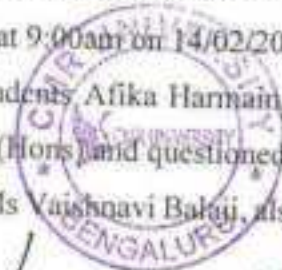
The Scope of the investigation was defined as

REPORT

Details of investigation done by Anti-Ragging Committee members

1. The complaint was received on 13/02/2020 by the Cell at 4:04 pm through an email addressed to the chairperson.
2. Since the classes for the day was concluded and also due to non-availability of the students, the investigation was scheduled at 9:00am on 14/02/2020.
3. The Committee summoned the 2 accused students Afika Harnain and Sneha Shree, both students of first year B.A., LL.B. (Hons) and questioned them.
4. The victim was identified by both of them as Ms Vaishnavi Balaji, also a student of first year B.A., LL.B. (Hons).

11. Both the students apologized to the victim and also gave a written apology letter addressed to the Committee. (Annexure 1 & 2)
12. In the meanwhile the parents of the victim visited the campus and they were made aware about the investigation procedure of the Committee and its outcome. They volunteered to withdraw the complaint and submitted a letter to the head of the institution that they do not have any further complaints and that they were satisfied by the timely and immediate action initiated by the institution. (Annexure 3)

Details of punishment

13. The Committee resolved to take action against the accused students by suitably reprimanding them and issuing a warning to them regarding indulging in similar activity in the future.

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16th May 2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08th May 2009 CMR University has constituted the following committee to eradicate/prohibit the ragging.

The objective of the Anti-Ragging Committee:

Anti-Ragging Committee is responsible for inculcating the Culture of a Ragging Free Environment in the Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad office bearers will work under the supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plans for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities. The Committee also would conduct awareness programs from time-to-time in the campus.

Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure compliance with the provisions of Regulations as well as the provisions of any law for the time being in force concerning ragging; and also, to monitor and oversee the performance of the Anti-Ragging Squad in prevention of ragging in the university. As per the order of the Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- ❖ Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
- ❖ Any act that Prevents, Disrupts Regular Academic Activity.
- ❖ Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or create Fear or Apprehension.
- ❖ Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
- ❖ Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm, or danger to Health.
- ❖ Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult, etc.
- ❖ Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.
- ❖ Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
- ❖ Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging.

Functions of Anti-ragging Committee:

- ❖ Displaying the charts and other material stating evil nature, punishment of Ragging, and also student discipline.
- ❖ Creation of a cordial and free atmosphere.
- ❖ Involving seniors and fresher's jointly in value-based cultural and other activities.
- ❖ Entrusting the responsibilities jointly.
- ❖ Inter-action and casual warning.
- ❖ Ensuring the spot solutions by adapting soft measures.
- ❖ In case of need, report to the nearest police station.

The Roles and Responsibilities of the Anti-ragging Committee shall be as under:

- ❖ To root out ragging in all its forms from the CMR University by preventing its occurrence by following the provisions of these regulations and punishing those who indulge in the same despite prohibition and prevention.
