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Brainstorming session on NEP & School Education at CMRIT on 6th September 2021



Bengaluru: The City is going to witness a brainstorming session on exploring the possibilities of finding opportunities for improving school education under the National Education Policy 2020. The two-day seminar is being hosted by Vidya Bharati in association with the CMR Group of Institutions.

The state-level seminar – Implementation of National Education Policy 2020 in the State of Karnataka: Strategies and Opportunities for School Education – is going to be formally inaugurated by Primary & Secondary Education Minister B C Nagesh, at 10 am on September 6 at the CMR Institute of Technology, Marathalli. The keynote speaker would be Prof M K Sridhar, Member, NEP Draft Committee & Member, UGC. The seminar will conclude on September 7.

While Karnataka has already been acknowledged as the pioneer state in India to get going with the implementation of the NEP, the CMR education group years ago created a conducive environment for effecting student-centric education as delineated in the NEP.

The topics to be deliberated upon at the seminar include opportunities and challenges in the implementation of early childhood care and education; an integrated approach to social studies with Bharatiya perspectives; Trends, Issues and Challenges in Language Education; and redesigning PUC to become an integral part of 4 years secondary education.

The outcome of the seminar, in the form of a report, will be shared with the Karnataka Education Department as a handbook on NEP 2020.

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
